On **Monday 2nd of March** the School and Vice Captains will be attending the *Halogen National Youth Leader's Day*. Halogen gathers together prominent leaders from all walks of life to be part of the day. It is a unique opportunity to expose young people to real-life stories of leaders in a variety of fields. In the past we have listened to Andrew Scipione, Mark Beretta, Ita Buttrose, Mike Baird, Bindi Irwin, Kurt Fearnley, Andy Griffiths, Anh Do and Nathan Hindmarsh. **ALL** students, parents and teachers who have attended in the past have highly rated the experience and thoroughly recommended the conference to others.

Students selected by their schools or community groups, as possessing leadership potential, attend these events. Some schools only send the students they have recently appointed to leadership positions such as School Captains. The program is designed to benefit any student who shows an interest in developing their leadership potential. Over 23,000 students along with their teachers/parents attend this event around Australia annually. All students in attendance will have access to a digital Certificate of Participation following the event.

Unfortunately, we are unable to take the whole Year 6 cohort as a school group, due to time constraints and previously booked excursions. However, we would like to offer this opportunity to the children in Year 6 to attend. The cost is \$55 per student and \$20 per adult. (Discounts apply with increased numbers.)

The venue is the International Convention Centre Sydney, Darling Drive, Darling Harbour, Sydney.

The program starts at 8:45am and concludes at 2:30pm

With this in mind, some groups in the past have stayed in Sydney the night before, others have driven on the morning of the event. We can put you in contact with others who are going, so as to aid with 'car-pooling' and perhaps sharing or group booking accommodation, if needed.
